In true form LPV rose to the Season of Covid in ways that were unique to our form, and more engaging than ever, in spite of - and true to form even perhaps because of - the challenges presented by the isolation of quarantine and social distancing. We mourn the passing of those we lost and we're thankful for the recovery of those in our circle that survived this debacle knowing that we still have far to go until the end of the pandemic. Election shenanigans didn't help with morale, but the struggle bound us together as it always does in our ongoing mission to actualize sanctuary, provide shelter and instil hope in climates where the breath of truth and the appearance of exceptional beauty too often instigates adversity.



FEBUARY 1 – PETER CRAMER & JACK WATERS @ MANA CONTEMPORARY

Fact, Fiction, Fantasy: Films by Peter Cramer and Jack Waters in partnership with the Film-Makers' Cooperative. Jack Waters and Peter Cramer present four films born from their decades-long collaboration in collectivist culture and practice. The two have worked together as filmmakers, performers, activists, archivists, and mentors. They are known for their experimental cross-disciplinary multimedia works that encompass experimental, non-narrative, documentary, and personal history strategies.

FEB 20 - MARCH 1 - PESTILENCE PART 1: GENERATOR @ LA MAMA DOWNSTAIRS THEATER

La MaMa in association with Allied Productions Inc. presented GENERATOR: Pestilence Part 1, the first of a three-part cycle and the most ambitious live art creation in the 35-year partnership of Jack Waters and Peter Cramer. Expressionistic and experimental, GENERATOR's narrative begins with a spark of energy triggering life on the planet.







MAY 1 – ZOOMING BELTANE

Due to Covid Restrictions on Greenthumb Gardens from holding public events the May 2020 season opening was held as a retrospective of our 10 years hosting NYC Beltane via ZOOM and Facebook Live.

JUNE 6 - 6 FEET - DANCERS I KNOW AND LOVE

As we recognize the 6 foot social distance parameters with a SPECIAL ZOOM presentation of "6 FEET- DANCERS I KNOW AND LOVE", Carl Michael George's film portrait of 3 dancer/founders of the POOL (Performance On One Leg) collective - Brian Taylor, Jack Waters and Peter Cramer.

Carl will introduce film and do Q & A along with Jack and Peter after the screening of the film. Captured in glorious 16mm and digitally restored for wider audiences.

JULY 28 TO SEPT 6 – IN THE REALM OF ANANSI FROM ASSISI: INSTALLATION BY PETER CRAMER

The inauguration of Le Petit Versailles' (LPV) 2020 garden season follows the Covid-19 months of sheltering in place. In The Realm of Anansi From Assisi, an installation designed by Peter Cramer, is comprised of freestanding elements from the Spring 2020 production of "GENERATOR: Pestilence Part 1" [pestilenza.com] at La MaMa Downstairs Theater, written and directed by Jack Waters with music compositions by John Michael Swartz and NYOBS with design collaborators Peter Cramer, Austin Windells, Mike Cacciatore, Chris Roberts, Ethan Shoshan, Bizzy Barefoot, and Rodrigo Chazaro. Music, video excerpts and scent score will be included as well as a live concert by NYOBS on August 20th @ 7:30pm.

JULY 30 – GEOFF HENDRICKS BIRTHDAY CELEBRATION AT LE PETIT VERSAILLES AND VIRTUAL

A hybrid of live and virtual presence featuring two videos:

Throw A Stone In The Water, a portrait of Geoffrey Hendricks by Berty Skuber (1994/15min.), and Geoff '80, Geoff Hendrick's 80th Birthday Celebration (2011/90 min.) by Peter Cramer and Jack Waters, produced by Lydia Grey and Geoff Hendricks. A spectacular event organized on Geoff's Cape Breton Island farm in Canada 2011, presenting Molissa Fenley and Dancers performing The Vessel Stories to String Quartet No. 4 (Buczak) by Phillip Glass, performed by the Blue Engine String Quartet; violinist Malcolm Goldstein, performing Sounding a Nimbus for Geoff, art by Martha Edelheit, Joan Jonas and many more!

AUGUST – DAYS OF OUR LIVES, A SOUND INSTALLATION BY TOM COLE AND LYDIA ECCLES/UNIVERSAL ALIENS

Outdoors in the real world in a socially-distant time when people can't crowd in for art, DAYS OF OUR LIVES is a collaborative sound installation of disembodied voices speaking to anyone passing—maybe pausing—by the Garden. Tom and Lydia have different voices, yet often are mutually implicated in one another's work. Each weekend had unique vocal content and appropriate theme music, offered in bite-sized modules for your convenience, and developing cumulatively over the month of August. The artists discuss their project (in the Garden or by zoom) on Saturday, September 12.

SEPT 13 – TOMPKINS SQUARE PARK RESISTANCE

The United Front Against Displacement will present a film screening and discussion. Located in an area where legendary struggles over housing have taken place, we'll screen segments from Clayton Patterson's film Captured about the Tompkins Square Park Police Riot, the 1988 attack by the NYPD on people resisting curfews and other restrictions placed on the park, measures that have continued and expanded to the present day. Afterwards, we will discuss efforts to link up New Yorkers protesting similar state-sponsored evictions from homes or public spaces.

OCT 2 TO 4 – THE CONTEMPLATIVE GARDEN by {amdpc} @ LPV AND VIRTUAL ZOOM

The world premiere of {a multi-dimensional performance company}, a collective of artivists founded on holistic wellness, mutual aid, and postmodern dance. An improvisational, spontaneous, and hybrid presentation. This work pays homage to NYC's very own Sun King of Downtown Dance, Raja Feather Kelly and is aptly subtitled: 10 Rajas, 11 Feathers, and a Dozen White Kelly's.



OCT 9 - INSECTS & FLOWERSEX @ LPV & Virtual ZOOM

A lively, living mixed-media series of shorts featuring films from 1930s to 1970s curated by Mushroom Archives' Bradley Eros. In keeping with Le Petit Versailles' vanguard legacy of creative disruption, the evening includes avant garde movies—such as Killers of the Insect World and Woody Woodpecker & The Termites from Mars—live sound by LeLe aka Lullady, a radio collage soundtrack by Jeanne Liotta and a live soundtrack performance by Pinc Louds. Several films will be presented in silence with perfume scents & tasty treats. The program opens Reel Ecologies: Films for a Sustainable City: the outdoor festival of The Museum of Reclaimed Urban Space (MoRUS) from September 10 – 13, 2020.

A workshop offered by long-time Allied collaborator **Kembra Pfahler** to share the best things she has learned as a working artist in NYC for over 30 years. Pfahler also hosts a podcast inviting other artists to just dive into performance art.

WRRQ COLLECTIVE

WRRQ is an intergenerational collective of queer/transgender multidisciplinary artists, chefs and activists. Together, wrrq, continually evolves as creative response to community needs. We make art for visual resistance and collective healing, including visual art, poetry, music, drag, video and culinary arts. We also take care of each other and our people by organizing community dinners, clothing swaps, vigils and street actions.

OUR TRIBUTE TO LINDA RICHARDSON

Her energy and action was felt as a catalyst and motivation throughout her tenure on Allied's board whose most recent activity was as a participant in Allied's continuation of the intra city Uptown/Out Of Town Project, a collaboration between Le Petit Versailles and the Uptown Development and Etertainment Corporation of which Linda was the link. Linda is greatly missed as her unique charm matched an unparalelled drive towards her lifelong merging of art, culture and social justice.


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
